Indwelling of the Holy Spirit

- 1) What is the indwelling of the Holy Spirit? (1 Cor.6:17)
- 2) We know that the Holy Spirit dwelling in someone means that he influences, directs and guides Christians which is intimacy of connection (Romans 8:9; John 14:23-24). What is produced from this intimate connection with the Holy Spirit? (Gal.5:22-23)
- 3) Do Christians have help to put to death the misdeeds of the body? (Rom.8:12-14; 1Cor.10:12-14; Titus 2:11-12)
- 4) How many baptisms are there for Christians and what are they? (Eph.4:5; Rom.6:1-8; Gal.3:27; 1Pet.3:20-21; Acts 1:8)
- 5) Is the baptism into Christ water baptism? (Rom.6:3-8; Gal.3:27) Describe the baptism into Christ.
- 6) Were people forgiven in Christ's ministry without water baptism? (Mk.5:34; Lk.7:48; Lk.23:43; John 8:30-31; John 8:11)
- 7) Was Paul thankful that he had not emphasized or practiced baptism and what was Paul sent to do? 1Cor.1:14, 17)
- 8) What is the power of God to save? (1Cor.1:18; Rom.1:16-17)
- 9) Have people been baptized in the Holy Spirit before water baptism? (Acts 9:17; Acts 10:44-48; Acts 11:14-18; Acts 15:7-11)
- 10) Is ones conscience clear before water baptism and is water baptism required for salvation? (1Pet.3:20-21)
- 11) As the waters of the flood could not have saved these eight persons had they not made use of the ark, so the water of baptism does not save the soul of anyone. What does water baptism testify to? (1Pet.3:20-21; Rom. 1:16; 3:24-25; 10:9-10; Mt. 3:11)

- 12) What is the "water" one is born again by? (Jn.3:5; James 1:18; 1Pet.1:23; Titus 3:5; Jn.15:3; Eph.5:25-27)
- 13) How did Christ stay baptized in the Holy Spirit? (Matt. 14:23; 17:21; Mark 1:35; 6:46; Luke 5:16; 6:12, 16; 9:18; 28:29; 22:32; John 17; Heb. 5:7)
- 14) Using the glass and pitcher example, describe the illustration of a "filling" and a "baptism".
- 15) Describe what the baptism in the Holy Spirit is (Jn.3:34; Isa.61:1; Lk.4:18-19; Acts 10:38; Lk.3:16; Acts 1:4-8; Acts 2:1-4, 17-18; Gal.3:14; Rom.15:29; Eph.3:19; Luke 24:49; John 14:12-16)
- 16) List the three different kinds of tongues (Acts 2:1-21; 1Cor.14:2-5; 1Cor.14:14, 15, 18)
- 17) Describe the baptism in the Holy Spirit according to (Jn.7:37-38)
- 18) Is the promise of the Spirit baptism for every person? (Jn.7:37-38; Acts 2:38-39; 5:32)
- 19) Were the disciples saved, born again, and converted before Pentecost? (Mt. 16:16 with 1 Jn. 5:1)
- 20) Were they filled with the Spirit with a great measure of power before Pentecost? (Mt. 10:1-8, 20)
- 21) Were they branches in Christ, possessors of eternal life (including Judas before he fell away), successful at preaching and healing? (Jn. 15:1-7; Mk. 6:7-13; Lk. 10; Jn. 17:2-3, 12; 10:27-29)
- 22) What are the conditions of receiving the Spirit? (Jn.7:37-39; Jn.14:15-17; Acts 5:32; Ps.42:2; 63:1; 143:6; Isaiah 41:17; Isaiah 44:3; Mt.11:28-30; Isa.12:3
- 23) Are you endued with power from on high to do the works of Christ? (Lk. 24:49; Jn. 7:37-39; 14:12-17; Acts 1:4-8; 3:6; 5:12-16; 19:11; Mk. 16:16-20; Heb. 2:3-4)
